ATTENDANCE:

Attendance is mandatory at all scheduled events. Contestants are required to comply with the following. .

1. Attend the practice session to be announced.
2. Participate in the Parade
3. Be present at auction sale to assist where needed during their scheduled shift.

*If the above requirement is not met, the contestant **will be billed a \$100 noncompliance fee**. This fee will be deducted from the current year's exhibitor's KKJLS Auction proceeds or must be paid prior to the NOV 1st KKJLS ENTRY DEADLINE for the following year's show.*

Queen's Contest: Saturday, January 18th 7:00 pm Jones Auditorium

KKJLS Auction: Saturday, February 1st

ATTIRE: Juniors 3-5 grade & Intermediate 6-8 grade - Juniors and Intermediate only compete in casual wear.

Seniors 9-12 grade- Seniors will compete in both casual wear and formal wear.

CONTESTANT NUMBERS:

Contestants will randomly draw their numbers in advance. Numbers will not be switched.

DRESSING ROOMS: No parents, friends, hairdressers, etc. will be allowed backstage during the pageant. Only contestants and authorized personnel will be allowed backstage. **NO CELL PHONES WILL BE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE!** Anyone that is not either a contestant or event staff must leave the staging area **45 minutes prior** to the start of the event. Queen's Contest staff will be available to aid contestants with last minute details. Contestants are expected to bring everything they need to compete in the pageant. Queen's Contest staff will not provide safety pins, bobby pins, etc.

INTERVIEWS: Each contestant will have a very short private interview before the start of the pageant. This will be the day of the pageant and the contestant **MUST** wear their casual wear attire. This will help the girls get comfortable in the interview process and help them with public speaking skills.

QUEENS CONTEST RULES

1. There will be 3 categories: Junior Queen (Elementary School 3-5 grades), Intermediate Queen (Jr. High 6-8 grades), and Senior Queen (High School 9-12 grades). All contestants must be enrolled in school, be single and never have been married. Ages as of September 1st.
2. In each category there will be a winner, first and second runner-up.
3. Contestants must be members of any 4-H, FFA, FCCLA in Kleberg-Kenedy Counties and duly elected by a majority vote of said organization. Contestant must have been a bona fide member of said organization since September of the current school year. Each contestant must have a project entered in the Livestock Show.
4. Each club or organization may submit three candidates - one from each category.
5. Queen contest entries and fees will be processed online according to Entry Section. **Information sheets and pictures for each contestant must be submitted to the Division Superintendent by the deadline set for all livestock show entries. - NOVEMBER 1ST DEADLINE**
6. Contestant must comply with rule #9. If this requirement is not met, the contestant **will be billed a \$100 noncompliance fee.** This fee will be deducted from the current year's exhibitor's KKJLS Auction proceeds or must be paid prior to the NOV 1st KKJLS ENTRY DEADLINE for the following year's show.
7. Queen's contest packet will be available for download on the KKJLS Website. All contestants are required to submit packet and entry prior to the November 1st deadline.
8. The Senior Queen, Intermediate Queen and Junior Queen and as 1st and 2nd Runner-Ups shall preside over the Kleberg-Kenedy County Junior Livestock Show to present awards at various judging events and at the official awards ceremony.
9. Contestants are required to comply with the following:
 1. Attend the practice session to be announced.
 2. Participate in the Parade
 3. Be present at auction sale to assist where needed during their scheduled shift.
10. Previous winners of a particular division are ineligible for competition in that division. They must compete in one of the other divisions provided grade requirements are met.
11. Contestants will randomly draw their individual contestant number at rehearsal. Numbers cannot be assigned or switched with other contestants.

12. No parents, friends, hairdressers, etc. will be allowed backstage during the pageant. Only contestants and authorized personnel will be allowed backstage. Anyone that is not either a contestant or event staff must leave the staging area 45 minutes prior to the start of the event. NO CELL PHONE WILL BE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE.

Queens contest staff will be available to aid contestants with last minute details. Contestants are expected to bring everything they need to compete in the pageant. Queens contest staff will not have nor provide safety pins, bobby pins, etc.

13. Pageant Judging and monitoring will consist of 3 judges and 1 accountant/auditor.

A. Accountant/auditor will sit at table with the 3 judges during the Queen's contest.

B. Judges will perform the initial tally of score sheets, sign, and personally hand to the account/auditor. The accountant/auditor will perform second tally to double check all scores.

C. At Queen's contest the accountant/auditor will confirm total scores for each division and personally hand final results to the Master of Ceremony. The Master of Ceremony will confirm with the accountant/ auditor verbally before announcing the winners on stage.

14. All score sheets will be available to be picked up by a contestant/parent during the KKJLS. At the conclusion of the KKJLS, all score sheets not picked up will be destroyed.
